NORTHVIEW HIGH SCHOOL ORIENTATION 2009-2010

It is our goal to issue all of our students their class schedules, hall lockers, and textbooks during their scheduled Orientation time slots. Please remember that June 12, 2009, as noted on the registration cards, was the last day to request schedule changes. There is a processing procedure which students may utilize to request schedule changes, once school has begun. Please keep in mind that schedule changes at this time are extremely rare and are allowed only for registration errors or academic requirements based on recently received FCAT scores, etc... Students will not have the opportunity to request schedule changes during the textbook issuing time. Textbooks will be issued to correspond with the student's schedule as of June 12, 2009. Locker assignments will also be printed on the class schedules, so students should take extra care not to leave their printed course schedules unattended. Parents who are driving their student to the school should drop them off and pick them up at the breezeway on the East side of the school.

All Returning 10th, 11th, and 12th Grade Student Orientation – August 18, 2009

All of these students should report immediately to the <u>Cafeteria</u> at their designated date and time. You will be asked to sit in an assigned area in the Cafeteria upon your arrival to help us keep the distribution of class schedules, hall lockers, and textbooks as orderly as possible. This process should take approximately 30 to 60 minutes. The upperclassmen Orientation schedule is as follows:

12th Grade – Tuesday, August 18, 2009 at 8:30 AM

11th Grade – Tuesday, August 18, 2009 at 10:00 AM

10th Grade – Tuesday, August 18, 2009 at 1:30 PM

9th Grade and New Student Orientation - August 20, 2009 at 8:30 AM

All incoming 9th grade and new students should report to the <u>Theater</u> at 8:30 AM on Thursday, August 20, 2009. Students will be issued schedules, lockers, and textbooks as part of the Orientation process. They also will be given information about some of the wonderful opportunities that are available to our Northview students which will also include a brief tour of the Northview campus. The entire process should take approximately 90 minutes, so parents are asked to be prompt in picking up their students at the breezeway after the conclusion of this activity. All other information pertinent to the 9th Grade and New Student Orientation will be given in the Theater that morning.
