Do you fit into any of these categories, then you might be eligible to receive services from HPRP.

Literally homeless (but not chronically homeless)

- An emergency shelter
- Place not meant for human habitation
- A transitional housing program

Precariously housed and at risk of homelessness

At risk of losing housing due to high housing costs or other negative conditions

Imminently at risk of homeless

- Being evicted from a private dwelling unit
- Being discharged within a week from an institution (can not be part of a case plan)
- Fleeing a Domestic Violence situation
- No appropriate subsequent housing options available and lack of financial resources to obtain housing



Eligibility Guidelines :

- Must be a US citizen
- Must be a resident of Escambia County
- Must have consultation with an HPRP Case Manager at Catholic Charities
- Must be 50% of AMI or below
- Must have a lease
- Must be homeless (rapid re-housing) or at risk of becoming homeless (prevention)
- Must have no appropriate housing options identified
- Must have lack of financial resources to maintain household
- Individual/family would be homeless **but for this assistance**

Income Guidelines

50% Area Median Income (AMI)

1 person	\$20,000
2 person	\$22,850
3 person	\$25,700
4 person	\$28,550
5 person	\$30,850
6 person	\$33,100
7 person	\$35,400
8 person	\$37,700

These resources are intended to be targeted and prioritized to serve those most in need AND who are most likely to achieve housing stability following the conclusion of the HPRP assistance.
