This is a partner tournament, your choice of partner. One lunker award per team.

Tournament Rules

- 1. Participants and registration. This tournament is open to all who have properly completed and signed their registration form and paid their entry fee; as well as, have never failed a polygraph test. If you are 17 years and younger, you must have a parent or guardian in the boat with you. A properly completed and signed entry form along with entry fee, check or cash, must be received no later than the registration deadline. Entry fees are not refundable. Registration deadline is 30 minutes prior to safe daylight. Must fish with a partner, a team consists of 2 people. Entry fees can be paid by cash or check. Please do not send cash through the mail. Make checks payable to "Log-A-Load for Kids". Mail entry forms and checks postmarked by April 5th to:

- 2. Pre-Tournament. Meeting at 5:00 am on April 13, 2013 under the tent.
- 3. <u>Safety.</u> Safe boating conduct must be observed at all times by anglers. A US Coast Guard approved life preserver must be worn anytime the combustion engine is operated above idle speed. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the boat during tournament hours. A boat inspection will be made prior to launch by the tournament director or his designee.
- 4. <u>Sportsmanship.</u> Competitors in this tournament are expected to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy, safety, and conservation at all times. Any infraction of these basic fundamentals may be deemed cause for disqualification.
- 5. <u>Tackle and Equipment.</u> Only artificial lures may be used. No live bait or prepared bait with the exception of pork rind strips, chunks, etc., may be used.
- 6. **Boat and Motor.** Any boat and motor may be used, but boats must have an aerated live well, **in operating condition**, and all safety equipment.
- 7. **Permitted Fishing Location.** All legal fishing waters accessible by boat from tournament site may be fished. No fishing within fifty yards of launch site or within fifty yards of other tournament anglers. All fishing must be done from boat.
- 8. Official Checkpoint. All competitors must be within sight of official checkpoint within regulation time (TO BE ANNOUNCED AT EACH TOURNAMENT). A checkpoint will be determined at tournament registration. Boat numbers must be turned in at weight site when returning to tournament headquarters. Check-in time is 3:00 pm. Scales open at 3:00 pm and will operate in flights based on your boat number.
- 9. Scoring. Winners will be determined by the pounds and ounces of the total boat catch (both partners). At no time will competitors have in their possession more than five (5) large-mouth, spotted, or red-eyed bass per boat. If more than the limit is brought to the tournament site, this will result in automatic disqualification. The official length for bass will be measured using the belly board (12 inch). Short fish will result in the loss of largest fish. Four-ounce penalty assessed per dead fish brought to tournament site. In case of tie, the largest fish will break the tie.
- Late Penalty. Competitors who are not at the official checkpoint at the designated time are disqualified.
 NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 11. <u>Mandatory On-Site Polygraph Tests.</u> I agree that if I place first or am randomly selected from the other winning places, I will voluntarily take a polygraph examination (lie detector test) upon the request of a representative of the tournament.
- 12. All competitors must follow all State and Federal fishing regulations.

By signing this form, I agree to abide by the rules of this tournament, and agree that all decisions made by the tournament director, in regard to this tournament, are final. I also agree to hold this tournament, its directors and sponsors and host marina harmless in case of any injury and/ or damage during participation in the tournament or any other tournament activities. Winners of cash and/or prizes given away in this tournament are responsible for all applicable taxes that may be due on items received from the tournament and are not the responsibility of the tournament or its directors.
