The vendor is responsible for obtaining all necessary permits and license required by Escambia County of Florida for mobile vending. Booth spaces for food vendors are available for \$35.00 (\$45.00 after October 24th 2015). Vendors must be in place by 9:00am and shall not be removed prior to 5:00 pm.
